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1. BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The Energy and Water Sector Education and Training Authority (EWSETA) is a statutory body established through the Skills Development Act No 97 of 1998 (the Act) to enable its stakeholders to advance the national and global position of the energy and water sector by facilitating the effective development of skills required to respond to related imperatives as envisaged in the National Development Plan (NDP).

The EWSETA is strategically positioned as an authority of skills development that effectively supports Government national plans and strategies. Furthermore, EWSETA is responsible for responding to the many skills-related needs of the sector and its respective labour markets.

By carrying out its primary mandate, the EWSETA incrementally achieves skills development imperatives and related outcomes over the long term.

2. OBJECTIVE

The objective of this Request for Information (RFI) is to invite suitably qualified service providers/accredited electricians to attend a compulsory site briefing at EWSETA's Cape House offices in order to:

- Assess the electrical infrastructure of the building.
- Identify potential issues, risks, and irregularities (including possible illegal connections).
- Provide EWSETA with detailed reports on findings.
- Recommend a comprehensive scope of work to address any identified issues.

This process is intended to inform EWSETA's subsequent procurement of electrical services.

The EWSETA offices are situated in the following addresses:

3. DELIVERABLES

At this stage, the scope of work will be informed by the findings of service providers after conducting the compulsory site briefing and assessment. Service providers are expected to:

- Conduct a **site inspection** of the EWSETA Cape House building to identify any electrical issues, risks, or illegal connections.
- Assess the overall **electrical infrastructure and compliance** with applicable regulations and standards.
- Investigate and analyse the **electricity bill** to determine if it aligns with actual consumption, and to identify any irregularities, inefficiencies, or potential savings.
- Provide EWSETA with a **detailed report** of findings and recommendations. (to be confirmed prior to the RFI closure)
- Develop a **proposed scope of work and specification** that will form the basis of a formal RFQ.

4. EVALUATION CRITERIA

As this is an RFI, no financial evaluation will be undertaken at this stage. Responses will be evaluated based on:

- Attendance at the compulsory briefing session.
- Completeness and quality of the assessment report.
- Professionalism and relevance of the proposed scope of work.
- Demonstrated knowledge of electrical compliance standards and safety regulations.
