INVITATION TO PARTICIPATE IN QCTO NATIONAL ROADSHOWS FOR PRIVATE ACCREDITED SKILLS DEVELOPMENT PROVIDERS (2026)

The Quality Council for Trades and Occupations (QCTO) is pleased to invite all Sector Education and Training Authorities (SETAs) to participate in the upcoming QCTO National Roadshows, scheduled to take place across various provinces from May to November 2026.

These roadshows form part of the QCTO's ongoing stakeholder engagement and capacity-building initiatives aimed at strengthening the quality assurance of implementation of occupational qualifications. Furthermore, sessions are intended to provide a platform for engagement with Skills Development Providers in the current period of transition. Recent feedback from surveys conducted with SDPs identified collaboration with QCTO quality partners as a critical component when engaging with occupational qualification skills development providers

The roadshows will focus on QCTO core business areas including:

- Qualification Development
- Accreditation
- Quality Assurance (Monitoring)
- Assessment and;
- Certification

The QCTO hereby invites SETAs to participate as strategic partners and stakeholders in these engagements. SETAs are encouraged to nominate representatives to participate in the sessions, contribute to planning (venues and catering) and to share sector-specific insights and developments relevant to occupational qualifications and skills development implementation.

- Western Cape (College of Cape Town): 16–17 September 2026
- Free State (Online): 06–07 October 2026
- Mpumalanga (Ehlanzeni TVET College): 13–14 October 2026
- Gauteng (South West Gauteng TVET College): 28–29 October 2026
- Eastern Cape (Buffalo City College): 03–04 November 2026
- KwaZulu-Natal (Umgungundlovu TVET College): 10–11 November 2026
